



Principal's letter

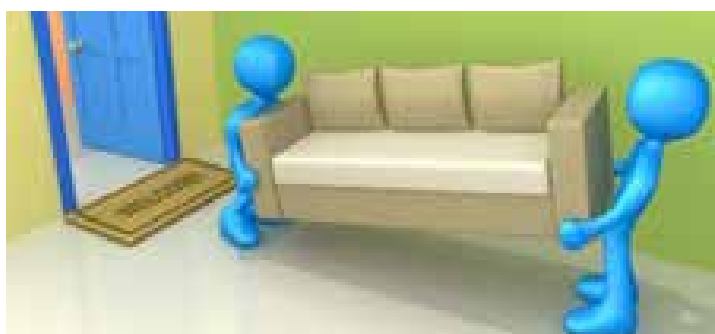
